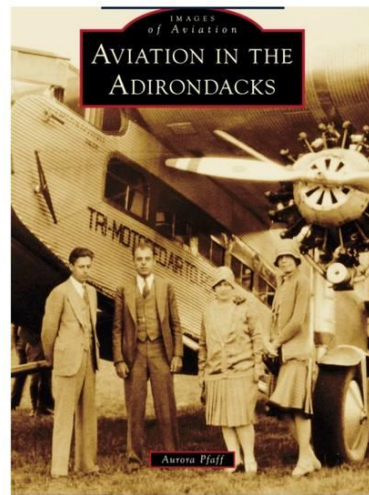

Aurora Pfaff Presents:
“Aviation in the Adirondacks”

Aurora Pfaff tells the story of pilots who flew the skies over the Adirondacks transporting goods and people, and the small towns and airfields that they called home.

Airplanes opened the Adirondack wilderness and made remote communities more easily accessible for tourists and adventurers. Yet this golden age for aviation would not last, for as car travel became easier and more affordable in the mid-to-late 20th century, air travel in the Adirondacks would fade in importance and necessity.

Aurora Wheeler Pfaff is a writer and editor living and working in New York State's Adirondack Park. She has a master's degree in English from Harvard University, but as a child dreamed of becoming an astronaut. She finally took her first flying lesson in 2022, and her book, “Aviation in the Adirondacks” was published in 2024.
